*Sir Knights and Ladies,*





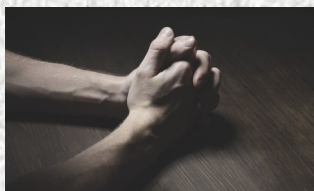
